Hitler is never satisfied

Yesterday, the German leader Adolf Hitler increased his demands over the Sudeteland. In the previous reunion with Chamberlain on September 15th they had arranged to give this ambitious man only some parts of the Sudetenland, but it seems that Hitler is an insatiable man so demands more.

In yesterday's meeting Hitler asked for all the Sudetenland "The Czech government is mistreating the Germans who live in the Sudetenland, and I want to rescue them! The Sudetenland is the last territorial claim which I have to make in Europe" said Hitler to justify why he wanted more land.

This conflict started when it came to light that Czechoslovakia was the



next country in Hitler's list. He ambioned that land and got the German Nazis from the Sudetenland to demand being part of Germany, and so another conflict started when they all started complaining. Chamberlain had promised the Czech leader Edward Benes to protect him in case of any problem with Germany

together with France and other countries. He tried to solve the problem but we all know that he is getting ready for another Great War, and that the last thing he wants to do is to waste time and armament in protecting a country such as Czechoslovakia.

For this reason, tension has been invading Europe all summer, and people are very worried about this conflict and have been alerted in case of bombing. Even magazines are publishing advertisements for air-raid protection and gas masks.

On the meeting of the 15th, Chamberlain thought that what Hitler was asking for was reasonable and was convinced that if he gave Hitler what he asked for, he would finally be appeased.
